Deadline

All applications must be postmarked on or before the due date of **May 31st** to qualify for the discounted rate. After this date, tuition must be paid in full.

Registration

Registration location and directions to the dorms and fields will be sent to you prior to the start of your camp session. (By email unless otherwise requested)

Day Campers: All campers need to register at 8 a.m. Monday on the first day of your camp at the UK Soccer Complex off Alumni Drive. Pick-up for 1/2 day campers is 12 noon. Pick-up for full day campers is 4:00 p.m.

All Other Camps: All campers (including commuters) must check-in during registration on the first day of camp at the Blanding-Kirwan Complex.

Check-Out

Camp ends after closing ceremonies on the last day of each camp. Check-out for all residential campers (including commuters) will take place **at the dormitories** at the conclusion of those ceremonies.

Accommodations

All rooms are air-conditioned. If you have a definite roommate preference, please send your application as early as possible. Both campers must request each other on their application. If you do not request a roommate, you will be assigned one.

Commuters/Non-Resident Day is from 8 a.m.-9 p.m.

Cancellations

The deposit of \$100.00 for the residential camp or \$50.00 for the day camp is subtracted from the total fee. **This deposit is non-refundable under any circumstance.**

Enrollment

To enroll, complete and return the attached application form along with the deposit and any of the medical information listed below. If you are sending an application after **May 31st**, **the total fee must be sent.**

Medical Information and Requirements

The University of Kentucky requires:

2. proof of a physical, dated within one year of camp. (The physical may be mailed separately from the application or presented to the camp athletic trainer at check-in.) Physician's Statement is acceptable in lieu of a physical, and
3. a copy of the front and back of camper's health insurance card.

NCAA rules prohibit payment of camp expenses (camp tuition, transportation, spending money, etc.) for prospects (9th grade and above) by University of Kentucky boosters. NCAA rules also prohibit free or reduced camp admissions for prospects. If you have any questions, notify camp officials prior to attending camp.

Coach Ian Collins



In his 18th season at Kentucky, Collins continues to build the men's program into a nationally recognized program. 2008 was one of the most successful seasons in school history. The Wildcats finished 12-4-5 and ended the season in second place in the rugged Conference USA - one point behind Tulsa, which was ranked No. 6 in the nation. Kentucky also reached the final of the C-USA Tournament for the second time in three years and eventually came up a little short losing on penalty kicks in the final. Along with the wins came national recognition as UK returned to the top 25 after a one-year absence, reaching as high as No. 18. Former goalkeeper Andy Gruenebaum won the 2008 MLS Cup with the Columbus Crew.

Coach Jon Lipsitz



Coach Lipsitz arrives in Lexington for his first season leading the Kentucky Women's program. Lipsitz, who owns a career record of 101-33-8 (.739) in seven seasons, comes to Lexington after spending the last four seasons as the head coach at Charlotte where he guided the 49ers to a 58-23-4 (.706) record including three straight Atlantic 10 titles in 2006, '07 and '08. Each season, Charlotte increased their win total going from 11 in 2005, to 13 in 2006, to 16 in 2007, to a school record 18 in 2008. Lipsitz capped the record breaking season with an NCAA second round appearance, defeating the Tennessee Lady Vols 2-0 in the first round. The 49ers finished the 2008 campaign ranked fifth nationally in scoring and 19th in shutout percentage. The 49ers' success on the field during Lipsitz's tenure translated into recruiting success, as well. The past two springs, he signed two of the highest-ranked recruiting classes in the program's history including the 19th-ranked class in the nation according to Soccer Buzz in 2007. While in Charlotte, he also coached seven Academic All-Americans and two athletic All-Americans.

Coach Lipsitz has served as a coach for the Region 2 and Region 3 Olympic Development Program. He holds the United States Soccer Federation "A" license.
